


Ghost Body - Kid Size



Grocery List:


- 1/2"x16"x16" Wood
- 2"x2"x42" Wood Fence Post (qty:2)
- 2" Wood/Drywall Screws (qty:11)
- Styrofoam Head
- Trick or Treat Bag (Ghost holds it)
- Epoxy Glue (Gorilla Glue)

Cut Pieces:

- A - 1/2"x16"x16" Wood
- B - 2"x2"x30" Wood
- C - 2"x2"x4" Wood
- D - 2"x2"x10" Wood (qty:2)
- E - 2"x2"x10" Wood Angle Cut (qty:2)
- F - 2"x2"x8" Wood

Directions:

(Note: Pre-drilling all holes ahead of time is recommended. It will keep wood from splitting. Use any size drill bit smaller than screw size.)

1. Cut all wood pieces to size provided.
2. Cut a 30 degree angle on one end of both piece 'E'. 
3. Using 2 screws line up piece 'C' with the bottom of piece 'B'. This will create a more stable base for the body assembly.
4. Using 1 screw attach piece 'D' to piece 'E'. You will do this twice. These are the arms of the assembly.
5. Using 1 screw per arm assembly, screw arm assembly onto each side of piece 'B' as shown. Using 3 screws attach piece 'F' to 'B' & 'E', to secure arms.
6. Using 2 screws attach body assembly to wood base. Position the body in the center (left to right) and roughly 2" from the back of the base.
7. Using Epoxy Glue, glue the styrofoam head onto the top of the body assembly. Let dry overnight. Once dry, put on white sheet and hang a basket from its arm. You are done.
